OCA President Sal Barberi welcomed the Membership and thanked everyone for their support. He thanked Jerry and Caryl Wilson for their selfless and continuous dedication to the OCA throughout the years.

Sal discussed the formation of a new National Committee to plan and organize the OCA National Meets. The Committee will be orchestrating the 2022 Nationals, which has not yet been decided, but will be held at a site where

we have successfully held a National Meet in the past. The delay in planning the 2022 Nationals was due to the uncertainty that the 2021 Nationals would occur, and the potential for being responsible for 2 hotel/site contracts, which the Club could not afford.

Our OCA Webmaster, Stefan Bartelski, is stepping down. We will need a new webmaster to help run the OCA Website and maintain the YM (Your Membership) program, which powers the website and tracks membership. We need more sponsors and advertisers for Journey With Olds, to help offset the cost of printing.

The OCA will be working to coordinate with the OCA Facebook site moderators, since there are 45,000 Facebook members and only 4300 paid OCA members. Many Facebook members believe that they are OCA members. It is also a bad reflection on the Oldsmobile Club of America when negative comments are posted on the Facebook page.

Sal is looking to publish a short video to promote the OCA to potential members, Chambers of Commerce, etc. in an effort to boost membership and increase exposure. The video would be geared toward young people, who are more likely to watch a presentation rather than read an article.

The Judging Committee is reviewing and proposing new guidelines and classes to include rewards for driving, and more types of cars, including "Donks" and "Low-Riders", etc., to increase interest in the Club. Many of these modified Oldsmobiles are expensive restorations, and the OCA would like to welcome these members into the shows and events.

Jeff Walsh, OCA Treasurer, highlighted some of the savings that have been realized this year due to decreases in accounting fees, website fees, and insurance costs. Separating National Meet finances from OCA Operating finances has produced clarity and the ability to monitor the status of our budget.

The Board of Directors participate in a Bimonthly Conference call, which is an informal discussion about current issues and upcoming trends. Anyone who has a topic that they would like the Board to discuss is welcome to contact their Zone Director, Ron Olson, so he can discuss at the conference call.

Sal acknowledged and thanked our **JWO** Editor, Shannon Olson, who has received the Golden Quill Award (since 2014!). Awesome job!

Sal also thanked the many volunteers who helped at the Nationals.

A new proposal for documenting the history and legacy of our OCA members and their Oldsmobiles has been presented to the members. The "Oral History" project is a published book that is created from OCA volunteers who are interviewed by the publisher. Their stories are transcribed into a printed book for sale to the members. Stories are also made available to be published in **JWO**.

An Election Committee will be named to coordinate the OCA elections for 2022. Any active member can be nominated for an OCA Board position or Zone Director. Details will be forthcoming in future **JWO** issues.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:12 pm, Dan motioned to adjourn the meeting, Michael 2nd. Meeting adjourned. The next meeting will be held on September 14 at the Sports Cafe. See you next month! Rocket on!
