FINDING A 100+ YEAR OLDS

I have been corresponding with a Bradley Potts from Belleville Illinois recently. I attended the Cars with Class at the Museum of Transportation on Father's day to look at the cars displayed. It was a rainy morning but cleared up by 10:30, and I went around 11:00. There were about 18 cars there and one of them was owned by Bradley Potts a 1901 curved dash Oldsmobile.

I spoke with Bradley and he mentioned that the car's number was 6240 in production and is the 12th oldest surviving curved dash Olds.

Back in the 20's and 30's James Melton a famous Opera singer, purchased the car for his personal collection and when he passed in 1948, the car was sold to a Dealership to be displayed on the showroom in Kingston New York. This dealership closed in 1967 and the car was auctioned off.

The Potts family purchased this car in 1967 and has been in the family since. The Dad has passed and the son Bradley is now bringing the car out for folks to see. This car is mostly original and Bradley started the car for me and it runs! Can you imagine owning the 12th oldest Oldsmobile in survival? The plus is that the car runs perfect for a 115 year old car. The tires are incorrect and he will be purchasing the correct tires for the car soon.

This car is as close as Belleville, what a surprise. When I originally spoke with Bradley I thought it was in pieces but was wrong as witnessed. I am working on getting this car to our Fun Show this year. It would be our center piece if he comes.
